Questions are below as well.

Speaking Part 1

Lists

- Do you make a list before going shopping? Why?
- Why is it important to make a shopping list?
- Do you make a list of your work? Does it work?
- Why do not some people like making lists?
- Do you prefer using a piece of paper or making a list on your phone?

Speaking Part 2

Take one minute to write some notes about the topic below, then talk for one to two minutes:

Describe a successful small business that you know about.

You should say:

- what business/company it is
- what this business does
- how you know about this business

and explain why you think this business/company is successful.

I'd like to ask you a question based on your talk:

- Do you think you would be successful in business?

Speaking Part 3

We have been talking about a successful business, now I'd like to talk about businesses in general.

- What qualities are required to become a company leader (or, CEO or, manager)?
- In general, what factors do you think to determine whether a small company will become successful or not?
- Do you think the latest technology plays an important role in a company's development?
- Which do you think is better, to start your own business or to work for someone else?
- What do you think of charitable organizations?
- Are the same qualities that make a successful businessperson required to run charities successfully?
